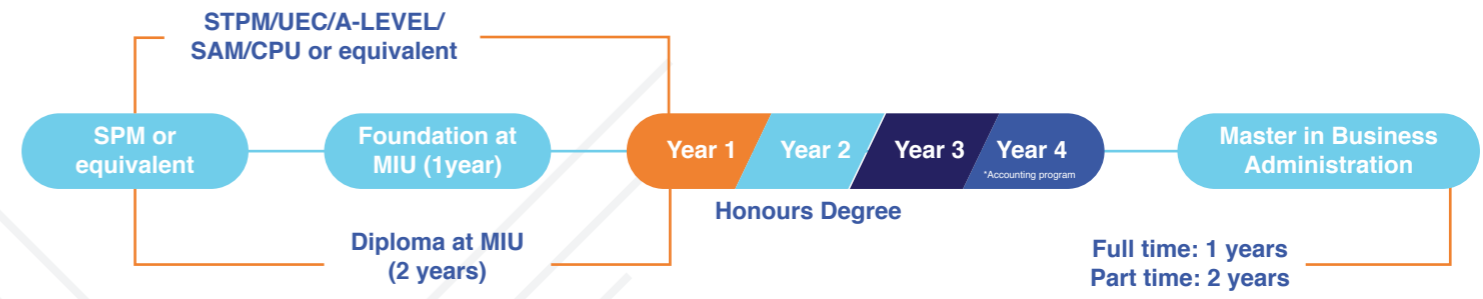

STAM	A pass in STAM with at least Grade Jayyid **AND pass in Maths and English in SPM or its equivalent
UEC	Pass with 5 Grade B **including Mathematics and English
A-LEVEL	Minimum of Grade C in 2 subjects; **AND pass in Maths and English in SPM or its equivalent
Matriculation/Foundation	Matriculation or Foundation with at least CGPA of 2.00
Australian Year 12	Pass South Australian Matriculation (SAM) with a Tertiary Entrance Rank (TER) 70 and Grade B in relevant subjects
Canadian Pre-U	Pass Canadian Pre-University (CPU) with an average of 70% in 6 relevant subjects
International Baccalaureate	Pass International Baccalaureate with a minimum of 24 points
Diploma	A Diploma (Level 4, MQF) with at least CGPA of 2.00
Advanced Diploma	An Advanced Diploma (Level 5, MQF) with at least CGPA of 2.00
